

About ClipWay

Used in tandem with Thuraya's IP broadband terminals and network, ClipWay from Geolink is one of the easiest ways to transmit high-quality live or pre-recorded video from any location within satellite coverage. This widely used software solution has been designed for use by mobile workers who operate in remote and challenging environments.

ClipWay breaks the process down into three simple steps – capture, adaptable compression and optimised transmission – while fully meeting the broadcasting standards of television companies. The media version of the solution supports functions such as live in full-screen format, a video cut tool and a news-gathering web application. Its transmission protocol is optimised for the Thuraya IP broadband network and will manage up to eight store-and-forward transmissions simultaneously. An interruptible foldback (IFB) channel is available to allow the studio to speak to a reporter in the field.

How does it work over Thuraya IP broadband terminals?

ClipWay is a software solution, so users need only a camera connected to a laptop loaded with the ClipWay application and an active Thuraya IP broadband terminal. ClipWay supports IP bonding, so if required the user can increase available bandwidth by utilising two or more Thuraya terminals. For live transmission, the user must first select a recipient in the application menu and then choose a preferred bitrate and whether to transmit full-screen or quarter screen. The solution takes the live feed from the camera, compresses the data and transmits it across the Thuraya IP broadband network. The incoming data is decoded in the studio on a dedicated server loaded with ClipWay software. Alternatively, users can access video feeds online via the ClipWay newsgathering server.

The streamlined ClipWay system architecture, its flexibility and its high-quality output make this a popular solution with broadcasters and media companies worldwide. It is adaptable to meet a range of scenarios, from a reporter operating alone in the field to multiple news teams reporting live from different locations.
